SUMMER SESSION ONE: MAY 10 through MAY 28

Classes will begin on Monday, May 10, except where noted in the printed schedule.

SUMMER SESSION TWO: JUNE 1 through JUNE 18

Classes will begin on Tuesday, June 1 except where noted in the printed schedule.

FINAL REGISTRATION for both Summer Sessions will take place in the Registrar's Office on Tuesday, May 4th from 9:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. - 4:30 p.m.
