"It's inspired me to take my next step, taking over leadership of America's Future Foundation, and to join the ranks of Atlas Network partners in achieving our shared vision of a free and prosperous society."

Previously, she served as director of programs for AFF, which is one Atlas Network's partner organizations, where she helped organize various social and educational events for young professionals in Washington, DC.

Cerquitella earned her bachelor's degree in political economics from Hillsdale College in 2006 and later completed a certificate in facilitation from Georgetown University School of Continuing Studies.
