Hillsdale featured in *U.S. News and World Report* annual rankings of country's top academic institutions

Hillsdale, Mich. – Hillsdale College has again been ranked among *U.S. News and World Report's* Best National Liberal Arts Colleges for 2019. Hillsdale is ranked 76 among the 229 liberal arts colleges assessed.

The rankings are based on a school's score out of 100, derived from criteria including evaluation by academic peers and high school guidance counselors, graduation and retention rates, student selectivity, alumni giving and faculty resources.
