Hillsdale College's Action Shooting Sports Team Wins Top Awards at National Competition

Student teams place high in multiple divisions at Scholastic Action Shooting Program

Hillsdale, Mich.— Hillsdale College congratulates the Hillsdale Action Shooting Sports Team on earning top national rankings in multiple divisions at the 2019 Scholastic Action Shooting Program College National Championships hosted in Talladega, Alabama.

"The team has worked incredibly hard to master its craft," said Adam Burlew, coach of the Hillsdale Action Shooting Sports Team. "The team competed against some of the best shooting sports programs in the country, and we are proud to see their discipline and dedication rewarded on a national stage."

Eight Hillsdale students traveled to Talladega, Alabama, to compete at the Scholastic Action Shooting Program (SASP). Teams of four competed across four divisions: 1911, optics rifle, iron rifle, and centerfire pistol.

Hillsdale's Team 1 claimed first place in the Iron Rifle–Collegiate Squad division. Hillsdale teams placed in the top five of three events overall, including:
