Radio Free Hillsdale student broadcasters recognized for work in audio newscast, audio documentary

Hillsdale, Mich. – Hillsdale College congratulates seniors Ryan Kelly Murphy and Jenna Suchyta on their awards from College Broadcasters Inc.'s National Student Production Awards, which recognize exceptional student work in media. Murphy won third place for Best Audio Newscast, and Suchyta's documentary, "The Problem of Pain," earned fourth place for Best Audio Documentary.

The work of Murphy and Suchyta was broadcast on *Radio Free Hillsdale*, WRFH 101.7 FM, Hillsdale College's student radio station, where Hillsdale College students produce and host a variety of news and talk programs.
