Hillsdale noted for excellence on national and regional scale

Hillsdale, Mich. – Hillsdale College has been recognized by *Forbes* as one of the top 650 universities in the country in its 2019 rankings. The rankings highlight the schools that provide the strongest academic experience, the highest level of career success, and the lowest level of debt.

Forbes emphasized the College's historic commitment to equality in education, noting that Hillsdale College was America's first institution of higher learning to forbid discrimination on the basis of race, religion, or gender. It also highlighted Hillsdale College's principled refusal of federal funding and the various ways students receive financial aid. Additionally, *Forbes* mentioned that students are very active and engaged in the 100+ clubs and Greek chapters that the College provides.

In addition to a national ranking, *Forbes* ranked universities in a variety of subcategories. Hillsdale College was ranked:
