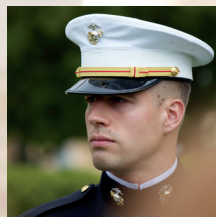
NICOLE AULT

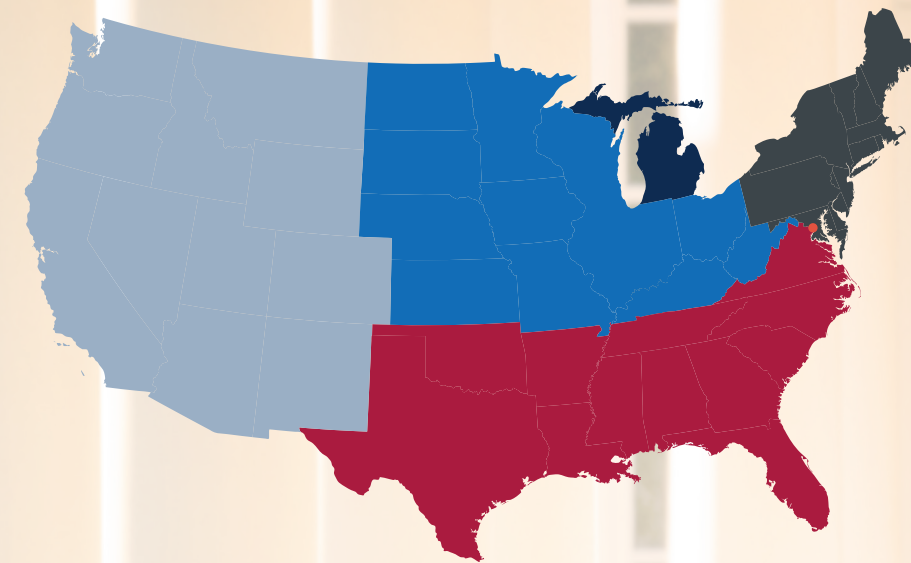
