"She is a talented artist who brings new life to classic musical pieces known and loved by many." At the concert, Spielberg performed inspired versions of classic pieces from musical theatre selections, including "I Don't Know How to Love Him" from "Jesus Christ Superstar," and "Tomorrow" from "Annie."

Robin Spielberg is known for her entertaining live performances, expressive techniques, and melodic composition style. She is described as the "heart and soul of interpretive solo piano." Spielberg has 20 recordings and appeared in over forty compilations worldwide. Her visit to Hillsdale marks the beginning of her 2023-2024 tour.
